



## **Take Advantage of Training on Executive Order 13522 – Creating Labor-Management Forums to Improve Delivery of Government Services**

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) is pleased to announce the launch of important web-based curriculum on Executive Order 13522. The **Introduction to Creating Labor-Management Forums: A Strategy for Improving Labor-Management Relations and Productivity at VA** describes how labor-management relations will be conducted at VA and defines expectations for collaboration between the VA and its labor partners under the new Executive Order 13522.

Open to all employees, the curriculum includes six courses that focus on:

**Course Six (ID: 1374586): What Type of Labor Relations Climate Do You Want At Your Facility?**
