Dear NAGE member:

As one of the first unions in the nation to support Vice President Biden's candidacy for President, NAGE is now working to ensure that we have strong presence at the National Convention in August.

While it is still not clear if the convention will be held virtually or not, this year's caucus process will be run by paper mail ballot for the first time replacing the traditional in-person congressional district caucuses. NAGE is asking for your support for NAGE-endorsed candidates running for delegate across the Commonwealth.

In order to vote in the Biden Caucus in the 4th congressional district, you must go online to <https://massdems.org/nationalconvention/> and complete the form to **request a paper ballot no later than April 22** to cast your vote. The Massachusetts Democratic party will then mail paper ballots to those who request them on April 24.

Once you receive your ballot, NAGE respectfully request that you vote for the following slate of candidate/s:

- **Kevin Doyle – Male Delegate**
- **Ruth Balsler – Female Delegate**
- **Debbie Drucker – Female Delegate**
- **Jody Shue – Female Alternate**

Completed ballots must be mailed back and post marked no later than Monday, May 4. For your convenience we have included a pre-addressed postage stamped envelope that you can use to mail your ballot back to the state party. The Massachusetts Democratic party is also offering this option when you fill out the form requesting a ballot.

On behalf of the NAGE family, I respectfully request your support for the above NAGE/Biden Delegate slate in the 4th congressional district so that we can ensure that NAGE has a strong voice at the Democratic National Convention in August in order to support our presumptive presidential nominee Joe Biden.
