As noted in a recent State House News article, the administration is working on a response plan with regard to the coronavirus. NAGE would like to assist in any way possible regarding the response strategy to help prevent the spread of the virus. We are looking to assist in providing information to our members about this evolving health and safety matter and doing our part to ensure a continued healthy and safe work environment.

In addition, NAGE is requesting that the administration notify all MassDOT employees about precautions that the Employer is taking with regard to the coronavirus, such as additional sanitization, cleaning, and preventative measures being implemented in the workplace. Due to the thousands of people interacting with our members on a daily basis, we are requesting additional sanitization to all public zones, including waiting areas and service counters.
