NOMINATION & ELECTION NOTICE

NOMINATIONS:

Nominations for officers of Local R1-168 will open on September 6, 2022. Nominations for officers will be accepted from the floor at the Local R1-168 Membership Meeting at the date, time, and place listed below. Any member who cannot attend the meeting may download all Nomination Forms from the NAGE website at www.nage.org/state/state-units-mwra; or contact Election Officer James Rucidlo at 617- 376-7266 or by email at jrucidlo@nage.org after September 6, 2022. All Forms must be returned to the Election Officer by 12 p.m. on September 26, 2022, by U.S. Mail to Local R1-168 Election Officer, 159 Burgin Parkway, Quincy, MA, 02169; by fax to James Rucidlo at (617) 472-7566; or by email to jrucidlo@nage.org. Nominations received after 12 p.m. on September 26, 2022, will not be valid.

The Local Executive Board will consist of seven (7) board officers: President, Executive Vice President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, Eastern Regional Vice President, Central Regional Vice President, and Western Regional Vice President. Candidates for regional vice president must be employed in the region for which they are seeking office.

Candidates for office must be members in good standing for one (1) year as of September 6, 2022. Members in good standing may nominate a candidate for any office. All nominations – including self-nominations - must be seconded. A person nominated for more than one position must select the office of their choice; no person may run for or hold more than one office. The term of office is three (3) years. Write-in ballots and absentee ballots will not be accepted.

It is the responsibility of the member making the nomination to confirm that the Election Officer receives all required forms – including seconds – before the close of the Nomination period. Ballots for the election of officers will be mailed to all members on or about September 28, 2022. To be eligible to vote, you must be a member in good standing as of September 26, 2022. Ballots will be picked up at the U.S. Post Office at 47 Washington St, Quincy at 10 a.m. Thursday, October 20, 2022, and tallied immediately thereafter at NAGE National HQ. In the event of a tie vote for any office, ballots to resolve the tie will be mailed immediately following the tally and counted on November 9, 2022. Members are welcome to attend.
