LOCAL R1-219 EXECUTIVE BOARD NOMINATION & ELECTION NOTICE

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for officers of Local R1-219 are now being accepted by Election Officer Thomas Flynn. Nomination Forms and Nomination Acceptance Forms are enclosed. Forms also may be downloaded from the NAGE website at www.nage.org/state/state-units-unit3 or by contacting Thomas Flynn at (617) 376-7246. Forms may be returned via U.S. Mail to NAGE Local R1-219 Election Officer, 159 Burgin Parkway, Quincy, MA, 02169; fax to (617) 472-7566; or email tflynn@nage.org before 12 p.m. December 22, 2022. The Local R1-219 Executive Board will consist of seven (7) board officers: President, Executive Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer, 1st Vice President (Mass DOT), 1st Vice President (Executive Branch), 2nd Vice President (Mass DOT), and 2nd Vice President (Executive Branch). Candidates for 1st and 2nd vice presidents of Mass DOT and the Executive Branch must be employed by the respective agency/block which they are seeking to represent. The term of office is three years. **Nominations (or seconds) received after 12 p.m. on December 22, 2022, will not be valid.**

Candidates for office must be members in good standing for one (1) year as of December 8, 2022. Members in good standing may nominate a candidate for any office. All nominations – including self-nominations - must be seconded. A person nominated for more than one position must select the office of their choice; no person may run for or hold more than one office. The term of office is three (3) years. Write-in ballots and absentee ballots will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of members making any nomination to ensure that their nominee returns a Nomination Acceptance Form. Please confirm that the Election Officer receives any nomination you make.

If you know of any member who has not received this notice, please have them contact the Election Officer immediately.

ELECTION

Ballots for the election of officers will be mailed to all members' last known home address on or about January 6, 2023. To be eligible to vote, you must be a member in good standing as of December 22, 2022. Ballots will be picked from the U.S. Post Office, located in Quincy, Massachusetts, at 10 a.m., Tuesday, February 7, 2023, and will be tallied immediately thereafter at NAGE Headquarters. Members are welcome to attend. In the event of a tie vote for any office, ballots to resolve the tie will be mailed immediately following the tally and counted on February 23, 2023.
