Nomination & Election Notice

NOMINATIONS

Nominations are now open for five (5) seats on the Executive Board of new NAGE Local 806: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Chief Steward. Local 806 is the newly-chartered Local representing Assistant Chief Court Officers employed by the Massachusetts Trial Court exclusively.

To be eligible to run for office you must be a member in good standing for one continuous year prior to the date nominations open (October 17, 2022); b) you must be permanently assigned as an Assistant Chief Court Officer.

All local members may nominate candidates for office. All nominations must be seconded. Self-nominations are permissible but must be seconded too. Candidates must provide written acceptance of nomination on the forms provided by the Election Officer.

All Nomination Forms must be submitted to Local Election Officer Thomas Flynn by Tuesday, November 1, 2022 at 12 p.m. It is the responsibility of the person making the nomination to confirm the Election Officer has received your nomination before the Nomination period closes.

ELECTION

Ballots will be mailed to Local 806 members on or about November 3, 2022, and will be counted Tuesday, November 22, 2022, at 10 a.m. at NAGE Headquarters, 159 Burgin Parkway, Quincy, Massachusetts. All candidates and members are welcome to attend the ballot tally.

To be eligible to vote, a member in good standing must be paying dues before the close of the Nomination period (November 1, 2022). Every member in good standing shall be eligible to vote for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Chief Steward. Write-in candidates will not be accepted.
