Candidates for office must be members in good standing for one (1) year as of June 29, 2018. Any member in good standing may nominate candidates for the office of President. No person may run for or hold more than one office. The term of office is three (3) years to run concurrent with the Local officers elected on April 26, 2018. Write in candidates and absentee ballots will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of the member making a nomination to ensure that his/her nominee returns a Nomination Acceptance Form by July 9, 2018.
