Re-Opened

NOMINATIONS

Nominations are re-opened for election of NAGE Local R5-136 Officers. Nominations and election results recorded previously are null and void.

Nominations are now being accepted for the offices of **President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Chief Steward** by Election Officer James Rucidlo. All nominations must be made by Tuesday, May 21, 2019, at 12 p.m., on Nomination Forms and Nomination Acceptance Forms provided by the Election Officer. Forms must be returned to Election Officer Rucidlo by Tuesday, May 21, 2019, by mailing to James Rucidlo, NAGE, 159 Burgin Parkway, Quincy, MA, 02169; by fax to James Rucidlo, 617-472-7566; or by email to jrucidlo@nage.org. Nominations received after 12 p.m. on May 21, 2019, will not be valid. It is the responsibility of the person making the nomination to confirm the Election Officer received the nomination before the Nomination period closes.

Candidates for office must be members in good standing for one (1) year as of May 2, 2019. All members in good standing may nominate a candidate for any office. A person nominated for more than one position must select the office of their choice; no person may run for or hold more than one office. The term of office is three (3) years. Write-in ballots and absentee ballots will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of a member making any nomination to ensure that their nominee returns a Nomination Acceptance Form by May 21, 2019. ELECTION

Ballots for the election of officers will be mailed to all members on or about May 23, 2019. To be eligible to vote, you must be a member in good standing as of May 21, 2019. Ballots will be picked up from the U.S. Post Office, located in Quincy, Massachusetts, at 12 p.m. Tuesday, June 18, 2019, and will be tallied immediately thereafter at NAGE Headquarters, 159 Burgin Parkway, Quincy, Massachusetts. In the event of a tie vote for any office, ballots to resolve the tie will be mailed immediately following the tally and counted on July 9, 2019. Members are welcome to attend.
