

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**Between the**  
**MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**  
**and the**  
**COALITION OF MASSDOT UNIONS for BARGAINING UNIT D**

**Mileage Reimbursement**

The parties agree that the private mileage reimbursement rate set forth in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between MassDOT and Union shall be increased to sixty-two cents (\$0.62) per mile. The provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective July 17, 2022 and shall be coterminous with the applicable provision of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

The parties further agree that the Secretary of Administration and Finance has the authority to increase or decrease the mileage rate upon providing 30 days advance notice to the parties. Said notice shall include the reason(s) for the change. It is understood, however, that the rate will not be set by the Secretary of Administration and Finance below forty (\$0.40) cents per mile.


